**BOOKING CONDITIONS**  
**Children** age 12 and under sharing a room = 50% adult rate  
**Single supplements:** Our policy is to avoid SS but under certain circumstances we may have to apply them.  
**Payment:** Deposit 25% upon confirmation of booking. Balance required 30 days prior to arrival.  
**Cancellation charges:** 90-31 days before travel - 25%. 30-0 days before travel - 100%

We are proud to work in partnership with our local communities. From a mud and stick classroom beginning in 2009 we now have a world class school and are an accredited exam centre. In addition to our school we offer free adult education opportunities in reading, writing, maths and computer studies and a community library that is open to all.

During the pandemic we started a community farm, for teaching and to guarantee food safety for our school children. Now a successful project, the farm feeds more than 300 children and staff daily, while ladies from the community farm their allotments for family food and to earn extra income.

Our latest projects, the fish farm and piggery, teach sustainable farming and guarantee quality nutrition to our growing schoolchildren.
